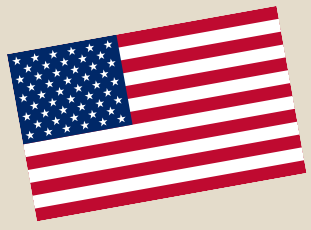




America 250/Colorado 150

August 5th- Being and Becoming Ute: The Story of an American Indian People by Dr. Sondra Jones

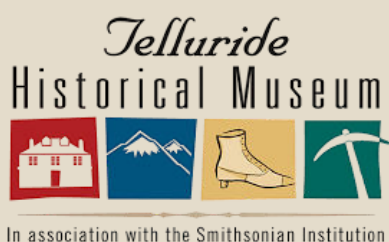
September 24th- The Survivors of the Clotilda: The Lost Stories of the Last Captives of the American Slave Trade by Hannah Durkin
